Contract Cancellation/Notice/Refunds: Not addressed

Offences & Penalties: (a) person who contravenes this Act or the regulations or an order or direction given under this Act or the regulations, or makes a false statement in an application, form, return, account, record, statement, instrument or other document completed or made under this Act or the regulations or under an order or direction given under this Act or the regulations; and (b) director or officer of a corporation who knowingly concurs in a contravention of this Act or the regulations or an order or direction given under this Act or the regulations or in the making of a false statement in an application, form, return, account, record, statement, instrument or other document completed or made under this Act or the regulations or under an order or direction given under this Act or the regulations is guilty of an offence and is liable on summary conviction to a fine of not less than \$2,000, and in default of payment of a fine or in addition to a fine, to imprisonment for a period not exceeding 6 months. (2) Notwithstanding subsection (1), where a corporation is convicted of an offence under subsection (1), it is liable to a fine of not more than \$25,000. To view these regulations please open.
